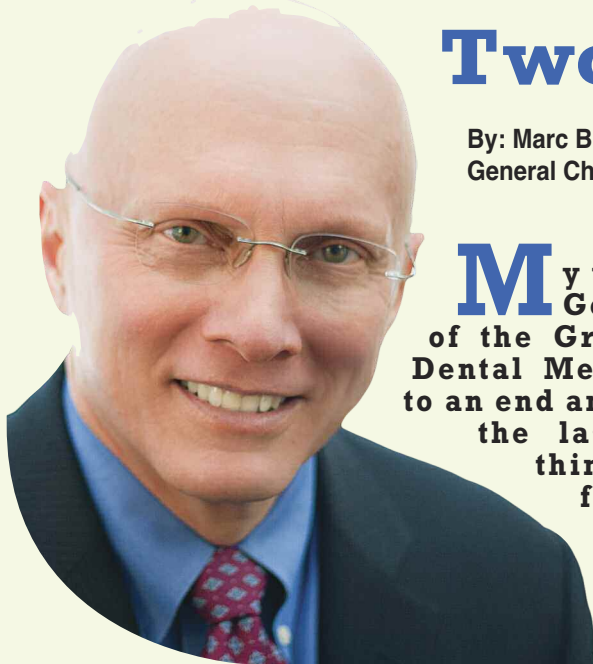

Two Years in the Fast Lane

My position as General Chairman proved to be both exhilarating and exhausting as I tried to navigate my way through this once in a lifetime opportunity, while continuing to stay deeply committed to my private practice and patients. There is an old saying that says, "If you want to get something done, give it to a busy person." I certainly learned how to balance a full-time practice with what I like to call my second full-time job as General Chairman of the largest dental meeting in the United States.

Another highlight this year was our attempt to engage younger dentists in our programming. We met with mixed success, but the core group of young dentists had good ideas and I am hopeful that the GNYDM will continue to attract, and track younger dentists, as we inspire them to get more involved and stay involved. I think dentistry continues to have a bright future and I am very proud to be standing in the company of so many great leaders in this profession.

Although I am truly proud of each and every innovation that I had a small hand in, what I will remember most about the last two years is not so much the growth and continued success of the Meeting, but the personal connections I made. The countless hours of preparation and hard work were truly enriched by the dedicated dental professionals and their families I met along the way. When it is all said and done, the friendships, the stories and the lives that have touched me, will remain in my mind, long after my reign as General Chairman is over.

I had the pleasure of traveling to meetings all over the country and the world and was able to bring back new and creative ideas to help make our Meeting stand out. The Expodental Meeting in Rimini, Italy is a good example. They implemented a digital meeting that clearly represents the wave of the future. They had a small, but separate pavilion dedicated to digital dentistry, with CBCTs, 3-D printers and scanners. That innovation inspired our Executive Director, Dr. Robert Edwab, and me to start something similar at our Meeting and seeing it work beautifully in Rimini is the prime reason why we are implementing it next year.

All in all, I am hopeful that my time as General Chairman has made a positive impact on the Meeting. I'm not quite sure what I am going to do with the "free" time that may suddenly present itself--when I no longer have to return phone calls, answer countless emails and take care of other issues that needed my attention, but I certainly hope I can remain an active participant in helping the Committee with programming and continuing to advise the General Chairmen that follow me.

Dr. Lauro Medrano-Saldana is our incoming GC for 2018-2019 and I have total faith in him. He is the first Hispanic General Chairman to be elected by the Greater New York Dental Meeting and his vision will take the Meeting to the next level as he cultivates international growth and strengthens new partnerships with both domestic and international dental organizations. Dr. Medrano-Saldana has made some wonderful connections with the South American and Latin American dental communities. His strength is truly in outreach and he has my full support as he embarks on his term as my successor.

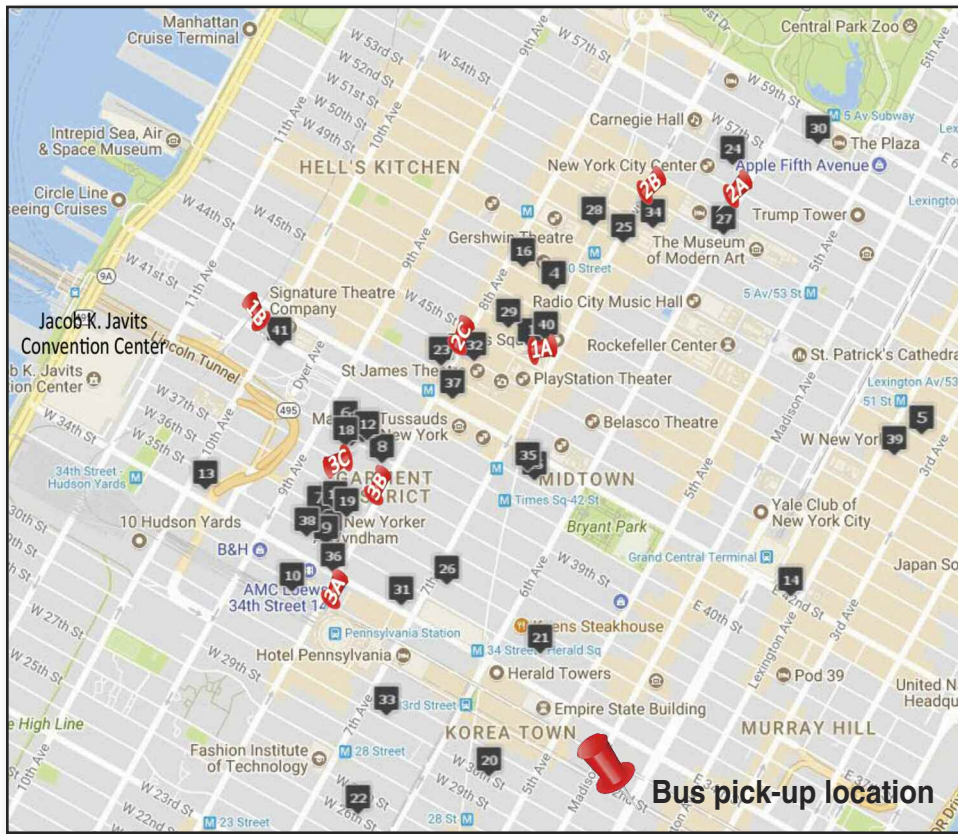

My 6-year Clinical Career from Non-Ergonomic Loupes

Bio: Dee Humphrey worked as a clinical dental hygienist prevention specialist for 6 years in a Tribal Community Dental Clinic in Northeast Oklahoma. She continues to educate the community through various prevention programs.

It is evident magnification in dentistry can increase the acuity of the oral cavity and enhance career longevity. However dental professionals must understand not all loupes are created equal in ergonomics, even though they claim to be! Comprehending the ergonomic issues that can arise from using improper loupe designs has never been more vital to one's career.

I bought my first pair of loupes in dental hygiene school and was told by the sales rep they would enhance career longevity by maintaining my ergonomics. After three years in clinical work I noticed a pinching pain that radiated down my left arm and began to lose feeling in two fingers.

I continued working and attempted to treat the symptoms with chiropractic care or deep tissue massages, excusing the feeling loss as 'okay' as it was not in my dominant hand. Within five years of starting my career, I was forced to seek serious medical attention. At a later date, neck surgery was required.

I asked the neurologist what could have caused my condition. They wanted me to find a way to minimize head tilting as I worked. They recommended I try a different brand of loupes, and I returned to work after recovering. Then, six months later, I needed lower back surgery. This surgery resulted in me permanently leaving clinical work.

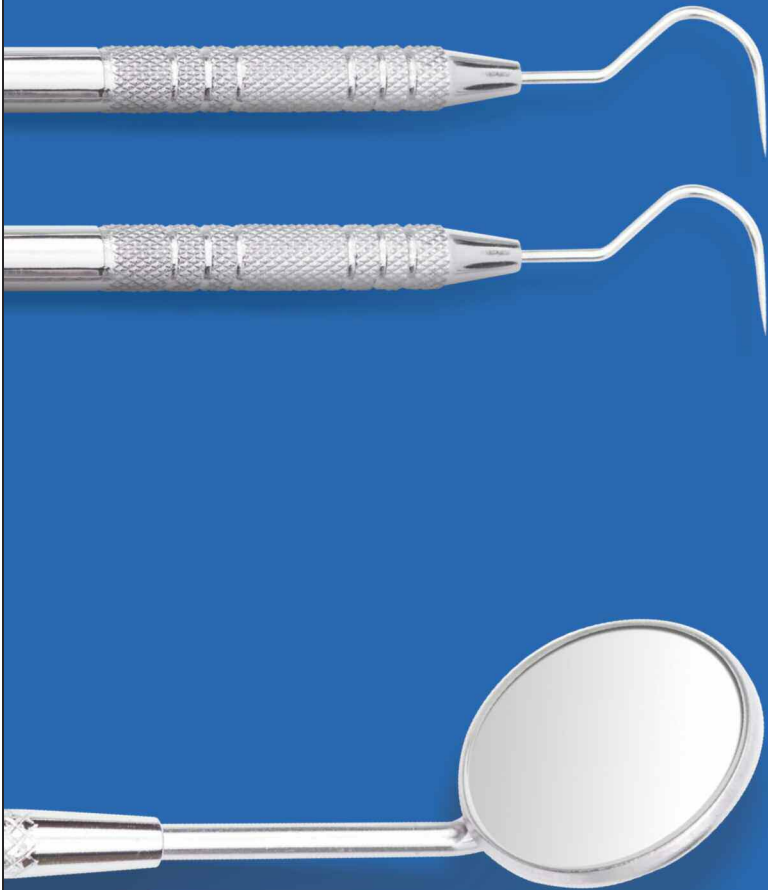

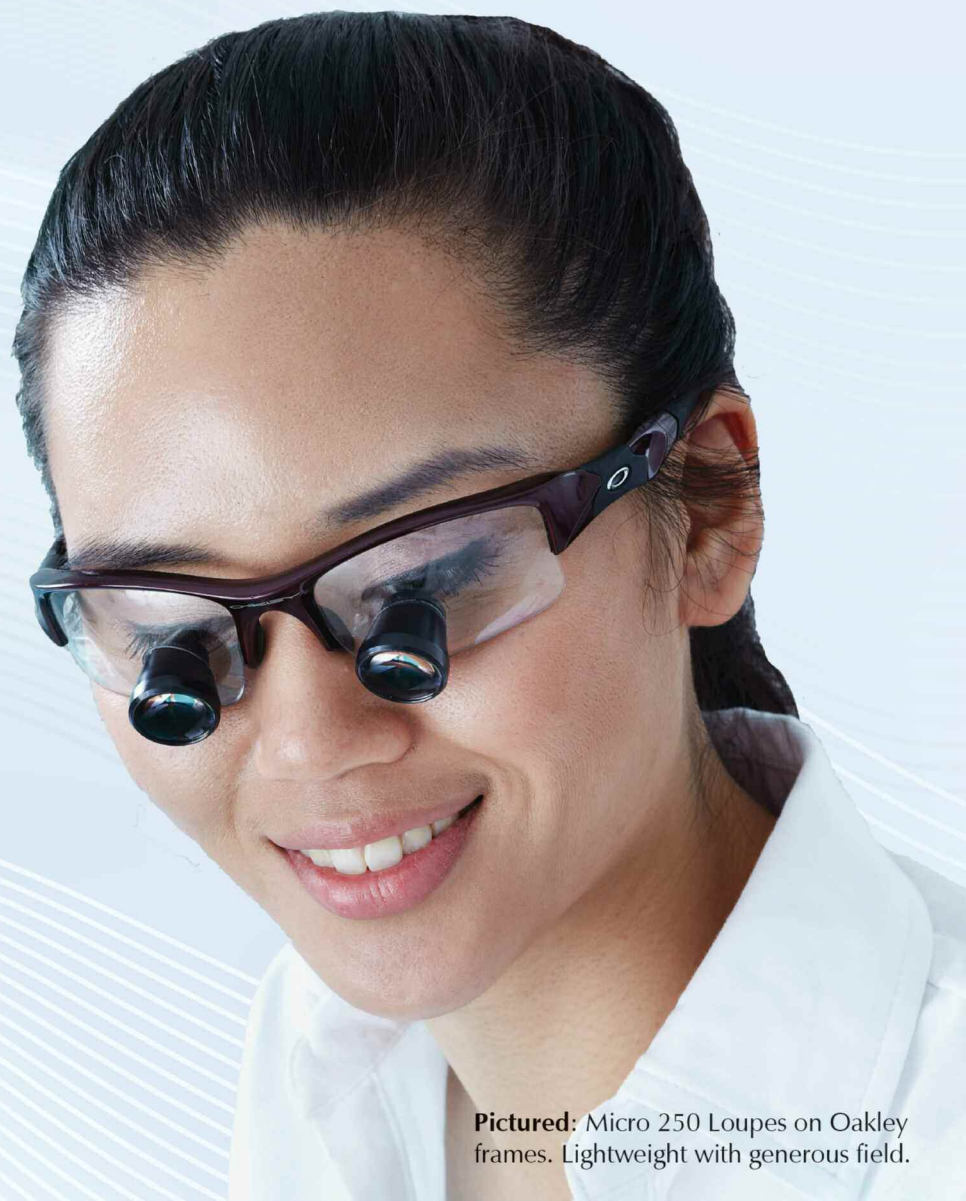

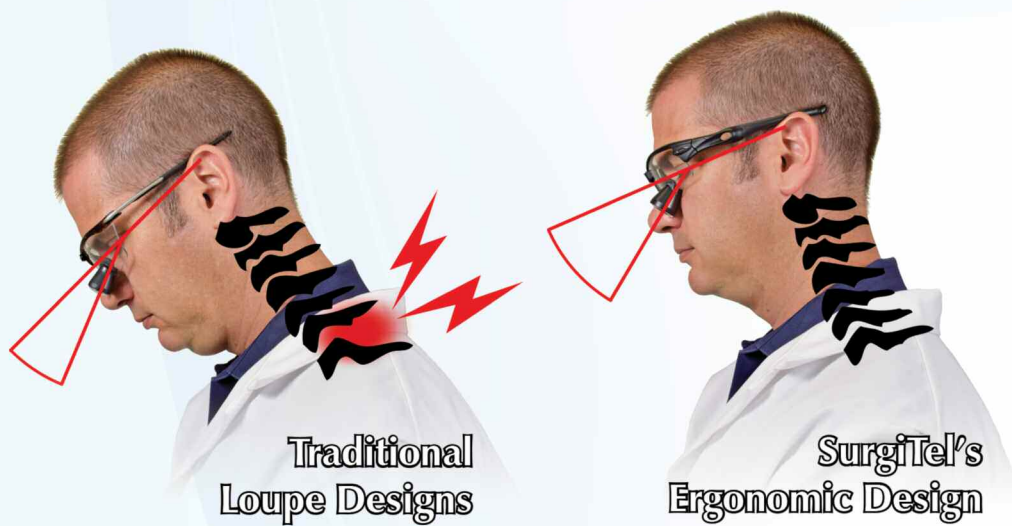
