NEW YORK, NY, USA: Organizers of the Greater New York Dental Meeting (GNYDM) have announced that this year's event will feature not one but two live dentistry arenas. The meeting will be held Friday, 26 November, through Wednesday, 1 December. There is no tuition and no pre-registration fee to attend.
