The Use of Dental Implants Provides Enhanced Solutions for Patients

he dental implant industry has continued to expand and grow during the past two decades to provide predictable treatment alternatives for patients who are missing teeth. There are short implants, long implants, standard diameter implants, wide implants. even wider implants, and transitional or narrow-diameter implants all providing solutions for the various anatomical presentations in both the maxillary and mandibular arches. Implant companies have focused on improving thread design, abutment connection geometry, surface texture, and surface treatment of dental implants during the manufacturing process. Innovation has also many ancillary p ires such as h guided-tissue regeneration, etc., which are now a routine part of the process to deliver a higher level of care to our patients. The evolution of these treatment modalities has created a significant need for continuing education and hands-on training. Last year in an unprecedented collaboration, the Greater New York Dental Meeting (GNYDM), the American Academy of Implant Dentistry (AAID), and the International Congress of Oral Implantology (ICOI) introduced the first World Dental Implant Expo at the annual GNYDM. This unique venue brought leading dental implant educators from around the world to New York City to present on important topics related to dental implant reconstruction and related procedures

Perhaps the most common use of dental implants is

single-tooth implant-supported restorations to replace a singular missing tooth. However more and more patients require multiple implants for multiple missing teeth in either arch, necessitating a variety of prosthetic components and restorative materials to finalize the desired prosthetic result. Most dental implant companies offer a wide selection of stock titanium abutments in a variety of shapes, and emergence profiles for both fixed and removable solutions. For esthetically demanding clinical presentations, zirconia abutments are also available. The move from hand-made analog laboratory procedures has been superseded by custom CAD/CAM solid titanium or zirconia abutments to create a shape that more closely resembles the morphology of the tooth to be replaced. The "digital workflow" is rapidly evolving, and clinicians need to keep abreast of these changes through many of the educational opportunities available through the AAID and the ICOI component societies world-wide

Barriers still exist for patients who do not have enough available bone for implant reconstruction. It is for this reason that the preservation of existing bone or growing new bone has become almost an industry unto itself. The expanded use of biological material has provided clinicians with new solutions to maintain or replace lost hard and soft tissue volume necessary to sustain dental implant placement or to enhance the esthetic outcome. In addition to autogenous bone grafting from the patient's symphysis, ramus, tibia, or hip to increase bone volume or promote new bone growth there are many different types of allografts (human cadaver bone) as well as zenografts (bovine bone), or synthetic alloplasts such as hydoxlapatite or tricalcium phosphate. Guided tissue regeneration (GTR) can also be aided by a variety of different types of resorbable and non-resorbable membranes that can be used alone or in conjunction

with grafting procedures. Autologous bioactive materials such as variations in platelet-rich fibrin (PRF) can function as a fibrin matrix developed from the patient's own blood.

In the author's opinion the single most important development in the last 20 years has been the advent of three-dimensional imaging technology for dental applications. The move from two-dimensional panoramic or periapical radiography to 3-D imaging and interactive treatment planning software has increased the diagnostic capability for all clinicians who are providing dental implants, bone grafting, oral surgery procedures, orthodontics and endodontics for their patients. The ability to assess each patient's individual anatomy through a CT/CBCT derived dataset helps clinicians to understand the pre-existing topography of the existing bone, the quality of the bone, the thickness of the buccal or lingual cortical plates, the path of the inferior alveolar nerve, the inner aspects of the maxillary sinus, the extent of the nasal cavity, and much, much more. Most clinicians who have adopted 3-D imaging cannot imagine going back to treatment planning with only periapical or panoramic radiography because of the improved vision to diagnose accurately helping to avoid potential complications by taking the guesswork out of the process.

The world of surgical and reconstructive dentistry has truly moved from the analog workflow to the digital universe. However this new "digital workflow" has different meanings to clinicians and the growing number of companies who are vying to provide solutions for the dental laboratory and the practitioner. Recent advances in intra-oral optical scanning technology has provided in-office solutions to capture margins of prepared teeth to receive milled crowns, leaving impression material and the Bunsen burner by the wayside. Dental laboratories have invested heavily on technology such as desktop optical scanners to digitize stone casts or impressions, and industrial-sized milling machines to meet the demand of both metal and zirconia-based restorations. The language of dentistry has also changed to include words like "scan-bodies", "CT-derived surgical guides", "monolithic zirconia", "DICOM", and "virtual teeth." Using optical scan technology for dental implants is becoming commonplace.

Technology has finally provided the ingredients to effectively move from the diagnostic phase, the surgical phase of implant placement, and the restorative phase with a total digital solution. We can now take the patient's existing dentition, complete a diagnostic wax-up of the desired restorative result, have the patient imaged with a CBCT scan device and a scannographic template worn during the scan, import the resulting data into an interactive treatment planning software application, and accurately plan and even simulate all aspects of the plan before the "scalpel touches the patient." This incredible amount of data provides the foundation to communicate information to everyone involved with the treatment process - through images, videos, or through the internet resulting in greater case acceptance by our patients. The final concept is to link the plan entirely with a CAD/CAM outcome including custom CAD/CAM milled bars, temporary restorations, custom abutments and full-arch monolithic zirconia milled restorations which are being fabricated today. Watch for innovations with 3-D printing technology happening now!

A MAXILLOFACIAL SURGEON FINDS ARMY CAREER U.S.ARMY FULFILLING

fter spending her childhood following her father to different military installations, Col. Hsu began her career in the Army Dental Corps as a general dentist at Schofield Barracks in Hawaii. She then became an oral and maxillofacial surgery resident at Tripler Army Medical Center in Hawaii. Following her residency she served as an oral and maxillofacial surgeon at Fort Knox, Kentucky, before taking command of the 673rd DCAS at JBLM in Washington.

Although she has a full-time job as commander, Hsu commits one day a week providing care at the Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery Department at Madigan Army Medical Center where she serves as part-time staff.

"It's a (important) balance," she said, "I dedicate the

majority of my time as the commander of a unit but slice out a portion of it to focus on my specialty and help mentor oral and maxillofacial surgery residents in the residency program.

PH2OH Promoting the Importance of Spit!

he oral cavity, according to Dr. Jack Dillenberg, the inaugural Dean for the Arizona School of Dentistry & Oral Health (ASDOH), "is the gateway and window into the health and body. The signs of nutritional deficiencies, general infections, and systemic diseases that affect the entire body may first become apparent in the oral cavity via lesions or other oral problems. Saliva plays a significant role in maintaining oral health and has a strong correlation to tooth decay."

Accessing Valuable Health Information

Exploring saliva's function, within the oral cavity, holds much promise to the many mysteries of the human body and to the genetic make-up of an individual. Saliva forms a thin film to protect against dental caries, tooth erosion, tooth abrasion, and periodontal disease; it may also be a useful tool to combat diseases within the body. Studies suggest saliva may be useful in detecting heart disease, acid reflux, oral cancer, breast cancer and diabetes. Currently, saliva is being used for HIV testing. es that integrate a whole person health approach.

Delivering New Technology

Dr. Tony Hashemian and his team at ASDOH have developed a diagnostic tool based on pH. The pH of Oral Health (PH2OH) initiative was developed to further explore the importance of saliva pH and its correlation to systemic conditions by introducing new technology for pH saliva testing. This new innovation involves a mobile phone application to capture time-sensitive data to communicate with healthcare providers in compliance with HIPAA regulations.

Dental teams currently use this saliva-testing examination tool to educate their patients, assist in preventive treatment planning, and to properly select dental materials that will initiate changes in the patient's oral hygiene. The dental team measures a patient's saliva pH using a pH-level litmus paper test strip. The litmus paper test strip turns a specific color depending on the pH of the saliva. The colors range from red—which indicates a strong acidic state (pH <3)—to dark blue or purple—which indicates a strong alkali state (pH >11).

The PH2OH IOS and Android app is designed to capture the pH value pertaining to the color on the pH litmus paper test strip. The app can manually set the pH value, or the user—whether healthcare provider or patient—can take a picture of a test strip and auto-calculate the value. Once set, the app will allow the user to save the data and track improvements to oral pH over time. This is only the beginning of what this program can accomplish for oral healthcare.

According to Dr. Jack Dillenberg, "I believe that the new PH2OH initiative will be a seminal communication and data gathering tool that will significantly help in the integration of oral health into the total person healthcare environment. This science and technology initiative will increase access valuable to

information improving health and quality of life

for the global community through a cost-effective, innovative solution."

I Wanted Without Neck-Pain

A fter using 2.5x loupes in dental school and early in my practice (around 7 years total), I decided to look into higher magnification to see how it could improve things for me. I had initially planned on going up to 3.5x, but after trying out Orascoptic's 4.8x loupes I was sold on the higher magnification. I recognized these loupes were heavier, but I did not take into account the effects it would have on me in the future.

I used these 4.8x loupes for the following eight years. In the last three years I developed increasing pain in my anterior neck and shoulder.


I saw a physical therapist for the last two years, with an appointment every two weeks. I was given exercises to help me work on my scalene muscles which had become aggravated with the heavy loupes and an excessive forward head tilt. The exercises would help me through the weekends, but once I was back at work with my loupes on, the pain would start all over again.

Around that time I took a week-long vacation in Playa del Carmen Mexico with my wife and two children. I had constant neck and shoulder pain during the entire trip. Sad to say, this is the first thing that comes to my mind about that vacation.

I read the Dentaltown forums frequently to gain valuable information on various topics. One day I searched on the topic of neck pain. I saw a post by a physical therapist that focused on dental ergonomics. They wrote about how a poor declination angle on loupes causes neck pain in scalene, as I was experiencing.

Searching more on the Dentaltown forums I came across a dentist who posted he had a set of SurgiTel

flip-up loupes that were very light and the declination angle could be adjusted to very steep angles. I noticed his loupes were 4.5x magnification, very similar to what I was using! I looked up SurgiTel online and got my local representative's name and number. My rep was Tim Faircloth.

I spoke with Tim over the phone about my situation with my current loupes, my pain, and what I had read on the Dentaltown forums. He told me that he could definitely help me. Tim came in and showed me the various loupes. He took pictures of my posture with my old loupes and with the SurgiTel loupes. I could easily see how much better my posture was with the SurgiTels'. My SurgiTel's are at 47 degrees and my Orascoptic's, even after they were returned, were only 28 degrees. Tim had also told me that I could easily change end caps on the loupes to either increase or decrease the working distance if I so desired; yet another great feature.

I am very happy with my new SurgiTel FLM loupes. The pain in my neck and shoulder has reduced tremendously and is continuing to get better. I feel that SurgiTel is way ahead of the game compared to their competitors in ergonomic features. The extremely light weight and easily customizable features are much better than other brands in the overall comfort of the practitioner. 




